eritage-something that is handed down from the past, as a tradition.

I joined Roma Lodge on March 2, 1956. As I enter my 8th and final year as president of the lodge I guess I have been around just about as long as anybody in the lodge. In 2025 the lodge will celebrate its 95th anniversary. 95 years of carrying on the Italian Heritage in Tulare County.

It was during April and May of 1930 when a group of Italian-Americans came together at the Tulare Woman's Clubhouse to form the lodge and elect officers. Back then it was the mission of the lodge to encourage Italian Immigrants living in the Tulare area to become American Citizens. *How times have changed*.

Over the years there are three long lasting traditions the lodge has continued for many years. First, is our monthly meetings, held the first Monday of each

month. That's nearly 1,000 meetings over the past 94 years. Next, is our annual ravioli dinner which was the social event of the year for many years in the Tulare community.

Finally, we are one of the few organizations who have been at every World Ag Expo since its inception in 1968. This

year will mark our 56th consecutive show where we serve our famous Italian Sausage sandwiches to visitors from all over the world.

In the beginning it was **Lupe Briano and Agnes Pelous** who stepped forward to organize and operate the first Roma Lodge booth at the California Farm Equipment Show. Cooking sausage sandwiches and pasta on a wooden pallet supplied by **Ben Curti**.

Now, 56 years later it is once again time for lodge members to come together and show the world we are proud of our Italian Heritage showcasing our great food to visitors. Many volunteers come each and every day to enjoy the great food.

These traditions don't just happen. There has been a long line of members who have served as chairs for the food booth. There is no exception this year as *Michael DePaoli, Melissa Watkins and Maci Daramy* are once again volunteering of their time and resources to organize and conduct this years main fundraiser for the lodge.

They have been doing the show for the last 11-years and hopefully somebody will step forward and take over this major fundraiser for the lodge next year.

As shown in the picture on the right, the **DePaoli** children have been active in



the lodge since they took a Roma Lodge junior member trip to the Fresno Zoo many years ago. They have certainly have embraced the concept of carrying on their Italian Heritage following in their grandmothers Lupe Briano willingness to set the standard for service to Roma Lodge.
