Presidents Message

t is hard to believe the picture of our Roma Lodge
Queen, *Gianna Benedetti* was taken at our *Columbus Day* celebration in 2017. Little did we know, at that time, we would have a pandemic and not be able to meet or have a Grand



Lodge convention, in person since the 2019 one held in Reno.

Gianna has moved on to Cal Poly, after being the valedictorian of her graduating class, the recipient of the \$5,000 Trinchero Perpetual Scholarship, the highest scholastic award given by the Grand Lodge, and Miss California of the Royal Pageant.

In 2018 Roma Lodge matched Gianna's ticket sales and submitted \$11,822, of which we received back a total of \$6,109.61, showing a net of \$198.61. Gianna received 4% of the total which was \$472.88 which is less than 4% of the yearly tuition fees at Cal Poly. The Grand Lodge queen in 2018 sold over \$30,221 in tickets.

I have said often and written countless recommendations to convince the Grand Lodge the queen contest has nothing to due with beauty, intelligence, charisma, charm or personality. "If you raise the most money, you Da Queen." I have been told and it is written in the contest rules, for local lodges, "It is a monetary achievement contest."

Gianna has graciously agreed to serve as our queen for another year and as Roma Lodge members we certainly appreciate her willingness to do so. However, we cannot expect her to drive over from Cal Poly for lodge meetings and activities to sell raffle tickets.

For her and Roma Lodge, the minimum ticket sales have to be equal to or greater than \$2,000. That would have to be 400 books of tickets (\$1 each or 6 for \$5). About 2,400 tickets would have to be filled out or address labels applied to each ticket.

We have to notify the Grand Lodge by **November 14th** if we plan to participate. We will decide at our November 1st meeting if we plan to participate. I know we have several junior members coming up in

the next 5-10 years and I'm sure we will have plenty worthy candidates to support!

RSVP Training



You may have noticed we are asking members to RSVP for lodge meetings and other activities. You may also be asking why?

The answer is pretty simple. Because of the pandemic we have not had a fundraiser for over two years. We have not had two annual ravioli drive-thru dinners and we missed the 2020 farm show food booth. These events are our major fundraisers.

However, we have continued to provide dinners at meetings and our Columbus Day activity. This is why it is important to have our raffles, and accurate counts for those who provide dinners so we do not have a lot of waste.

We do not want to discourage members from attending our meetings or other activities because they forgot to RSVP. There are times when you do RSVP and something comes up and they cannot attend. This is fine.

We had RSVP's for 62 for Columbus Day and we had about 70 with some who did not RSVP and some that did and did not attend. We just want to provide those in charge of meals a better idea of how many people who are attending. The old days of cooking for 100 and having 40 show up are over. *Just plan to RSVP if you plan to attend a lodge activity. Thanks.*
