Out of the Ashes!

On Monday, June 17th, Ben Curti received a call from his security company that a fire alarm was going off in the



equipment room at the *Curtimade Dairy* in Waukena.

Ben and his wife Elisabeth arrived at the dairy to see the picture above with the equipment room and more importantly the upstairs office engulfed in flames resulting in a total loss. A loss of nearly 110 years of Curti Family history in the dairy business.

If anything good can come from the ashes it was the outpouring of support from the Waukena community. Support that included hauling over 3,000 milking cows to nearby dairies, organizing employees, arranging for emergency scheduling, getting a temporary office setup, the list goes on and on. Tessa and *Stuart Hall*, who run the day-to-day operation of the

dairy, had to make dozens of decisions in response to such a devasting fire.

Family patriarch of the Ben Curti Family, Miro Curti was the Roma Lodge President in 1936-
