The Mission Continues!

It was April 13, 1930 when the first meeting of Roma Lodge #1573 was held in Tulare. On May 25, 1930 the installation of officers and 86 of the 115 charter members were initiated into the lodge. The primary

mission was to encourage recent Italian Immigrants to become American Citizens.

Now, some 94 years later our mission has changed, however, carrying on the Italian Culture in Tulare County remains strong.
