annual ravioli dinner, worked countless hours during the early days of our booth at the farm show when it first started back at the Tulare Fair Grounds.

Agnes was born on July 17, 1922 in La Puente, California to John and Maria Manassero who came to the America from Bene Vagienna, in the province of Cuneo, in the Piedmonte Region of northern Italy in 1920. She married Alex Pelous in 1944 and moved to Lindsay in 1957 and joined the lodge in 1958.

Agnes and Alex gave of their time and resources to make Roma Lodge a success in those early days of the organization. Although, Alex was of French heritage he had many Italian friends who he worked with in his farming and custom bean harvesting business.



They both enjoyed their time at Roma Lodge meetings and activities and did their part in promoting the Italian culture. Roma Lodge would like to thank both of them and congratulate Agnes on celebrating her 100th birthday. We wish her many more birthdays to come.

# T-Frank!

here were many Roma Lodge members on hand to bid our final farewell to *Brother*Frank Goni on July 18th. Frank fell and hit his head while working on his dairy farm and passed away on July 3rd. Frank was born in Spain and immigrated to America and settled in Tipton in the 1970's and quickly made friends with many of our Italian Immigrants

who started Roma Lodge many years ago. One of which was Charlie Aspesi who farmed just east of Tipton.

Charlie introduced Frank to Olivia Lerda and they were married in 1980. Frank joined the lodge the same year and was a 42year member of Roma Lodge. Olivia served as



lodge president for three consecutive terms from 1987-1992 making Frank the First Gentlemen of the lodge as Olivia was the first woman president of Roma Lodge.

If there was ever anyone who dedicated herself to Roma Lodge, carrying on her Italian culture it was Olivia. She served the lodge in many capacities and Frank was at her side doing his best as *First Gentleman*.

Tragically, Olivia's brother, Russel passed away in May of 1995 and she passed away in October of the

same year. This left
Frank and son Joseph
and daughter Joanna
to run the family operation. Frank quickly
learned the dairy and
farming business after
being a Basque sheep
herder all over the
western United States
when he first came to



America. As an immigrant Frank quickly befriended many of our lodge members who were immigrants from Italy.

Frank was always more comfortable in the kitchen then he was sitting at the head table. People are often asked what they want to be remembered for when their journey on this earth is over. I know Roma Lodge members will always remember Frank for his famous risotto he



cooked every year to go along with our Italian sausage in celebration of our lodge anniversary.

Being a dairy farmer we all know it is a 24/7 operation and Frank did not have a lot of free time to devote to the lodge. However, he would make sure when April rolled around he could be counted upon to secretly make the concoction of herbs, spices and chicken stock to make the risotto so delicious.

This year he arrived about 4 o'clock and we sat and chatted while we waited for Joseph to show up with the sauce pan with all the key ingredients for the cooking the risotto.

I always delighted in my conversations with Frank or T-Frank as I called him, which translates to Uncle Frank. He said, "Dutto, I remember coming to these lodge meetings and seeing all the old-timers like your dad, your uncles and all the great families of the lodge. Now, we are the old-timers!"

Yes, Frank we are the old timers and we miss those folks who started the lodge over 92-years ago and have entrusted us to carryon our Italian Heritage. You have done more than your share for the lodge and it didn't matter if you were Basque



or Italian. What you were was a hard worker, loyal friend and someone who valued and treasured your citizenship as an American. Just as Olivia passed the torch to you, now, you have passed the torch to *Joseph* and *Joanna* and your grandchildren *Quinn* and *Mason*. I also remember that meeting in April when Frank won the 50-50 drawing and donated the money back to the lodge. That was *Frank Goni*. *Farewell Brother Frank, may you rest in peace*. *We will miss your friendship and loyalty to Roma Lodge*.
