

They donated \$15 to help establish the lodge and have continued to carryon the Italian Culture in Kings County for over 95 years!

It was a lovely event, with great food, a table of memorabilia of the history of the lodge, beautiful setting at the golf course and an opportunity to re-

member those who have come before us as members of the Order.


